

Class of 2021 and Beyond

For the Class of 2021 and thereafter, students who have not demonstrated proficiency on the ELA 10 and Algebra 1 assessments, and have taken all PARCC assessments associated with the high-school level courses for which they were eligible*, can demonstrate graduation assessment proficiency by meeting the criteria of the portfolio appeals process.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS (ELA) **PARCC ELA Grade 10 (must take and pass)**

*If passing score is not met on PARCC ELA Grade 10, then the student
must have taken*

PARCC ELA Grade 9
and

PARCC ELA Grade 10
and

PARCC ELA Grade 11
before they can

Meet the criteria of the NJDOE Portfolio Appeal

MATHEMATICS **PARCC Algebra I (must take and pass)**

*If passing score is not met on PARCC Algebra 1, then the student
must have taken*

PARCC Algebra I
and

PARCC Geometry
And

PARCC Algebra II (if eligible*)
before they can

Meet the criteria of the NJDOE Portfolio Appeal

Note: *"Eligible" is defined as a student who is enrolled in a high-school level course for which there is a PARCC test. This includes all of these courses: Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, ELA 9, ELA 10, and ELA 11.
