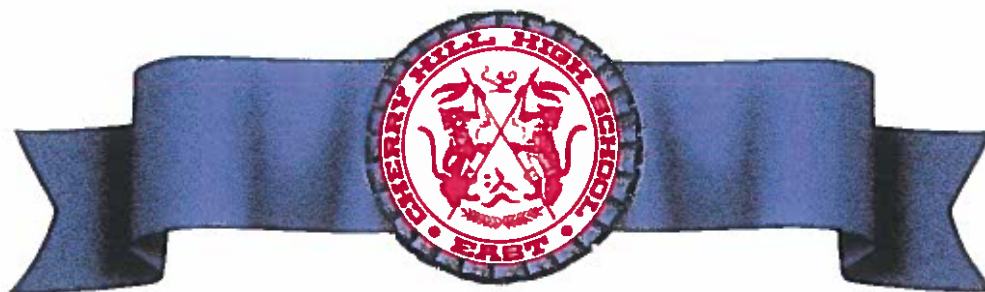

## INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS

- An expansive theater program offers students many opportunities to perform throughout the year. This program taps into the talents of younger students throughout the district, involving them in selected performances with East students.

## STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

- **ATHLETICS**—More than 1,100 male and female students participate on 28 varsity teams.
- **EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS**—More than 1,500 students participate in 69 programs focused on drama, student government, publications, vocal and instrumental music, and academic, business, community service, and ethnic culture clubs.

## STUDENT AWARDS

- **ENGLISH**—The school newspaper, *Eastside*, is consistently recognized as the top newspaper in the country by the American Scholastic Press Association. The school literary magazine, *Demogorgan*, received a First Place Award from ASPA.
- **SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS**—Recognition in international, national, state, and regional competitions in mathematics, biology, physics, and chemistry.
- **BUSINESS**—Top finishes in regional and state DECA competitions; multiple top-ten finalists at the International DECA Conference.
- **ATHLETICS**—Championship caliber teams! Multiple State and Conference Championships won by Boys and Girls Swimming, Boys and Girls Tennis, Boys and Girls Volleyball, Soccer, Bowling, Track, and Golf.
- **MUSIC AND DRAMA**—National and state awards in vocal music, jazz band, marching band, wind ensemble, acting, and theatrical productions.

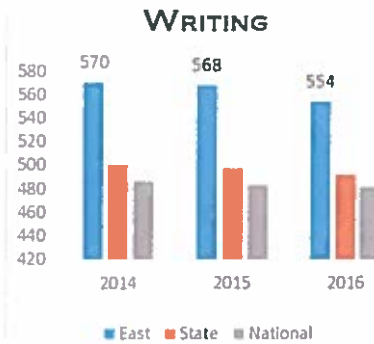
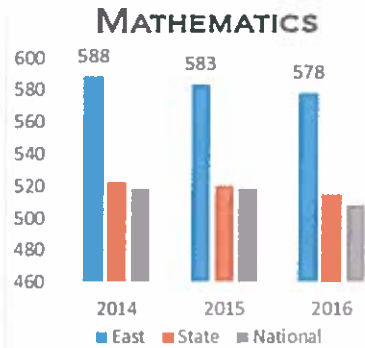
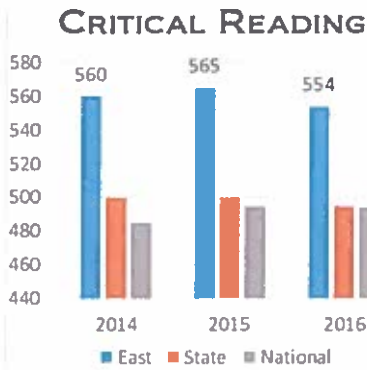
