KINDERGARTEN & FIRST GRADE REGISTRATION

(For Children Entering Public School for the First Time)

Children must be five years old on or before October 1, 2016 In order to be eligible for Kindergarten. If your child is currently enrolled in our pre-kindergarten program and you wish to meet with the school nurse to review medical requirements, you may do so on your scheduled registration day. Current Kindergarten students in Cherry Hill Public Schools do not need to re-register for first grade.

All Kindergarten and First Grade Registration is conducted centrally at the Malberg Administration Building at 45 Ranoldo Terrace. Each elementary school has its own registration date. The dates and times are listed below.
