Dear Beck Parents/Guardians,

October is National Bullying Prevention Awareness Month

Beck students will participate in a variety of activities to combat bullying. Parents/guardians can learn more about bullying and find age appropriate videos for home at YouTube @StopBullyingGov.

- On Monday, Dr. Kerry Magro shared his story of growing up with autism and being bullied in a school-wide assembly. He told students how bullying impacted him as a young person and
 - how he learned to combat bullying and be an upstander, despite his own struggles with autism. Students showed RESPECT and COMPASSION throughout the assembly and asked many questions at the end.
- Over the past two weeks, all Teams in all grades participated in an Harassment, Intimidation & Bullying presentation with their grade level principal and counselor. This <u>slideshow</u> reviewed the definition of HIB, the difference between HIB and peer conflict and identified supports and resources at school. <u>Words are like toothpaste</u>...
- Next weekend, Beck is partnering with Rosa, Carusi and JCRC to help combat anti-Semitism and hate by promoting participation in the March of Remembrance on October 15 at the <u>JCC</u>. Students viewed this <u>slideshow</u> in advisory class last week and may sign up for the event in their Google Classroom. Donations are optional to attend the march. Students should wear Beck gear. Families and staff are welcomed and encouraged to participate. We hope to see many Beck, Rosa & Carusi students walking in solidarity to combat hate. - October 15-21, 2023 is National School Violence Awareness Week & Safe Schools Week.
 During this week, New Jersey schools are required to provide opportunities to discuss



methods for keeping schools safe from violence, to consider school safety and security plans, and to learn how to recognize students in need of help.

October 23-27, 2023 is <u>Red Ribbon Week</u>. Our Peer Leaders have a week of planned dress up days to highlight healthy, safe and positive behavior choices for all students.

Getting Academic Help

We are half-way through our 1st Marking Period and parents/guardians will receive interim reports on October 18. We do know that many parents/guardians and students check their grades frequently through the Genesis Parent Portal. The habit of checking on assignments and grades is a necessary life skill for all students to learn. If your student or you is concerned about their academic progress or performance in a particular subject, we are here to help!

 Please always encourage your student to contact their teacher. We encourage students to self-advocate in the middle grades, knowing that parents/guardians are there to encourage and assist their students. It is great to help your student rehearse how they can ask for extra help or assist them in drafting an email to their teacher.

How is extra help offered during the school day?

- On the extended class day (78 minute class), teachers utilize the extra time to work with small groups, review challenging content and reinforce newly learned skills.
- On Wednesdays & Fridays in Advisory, students visit a Core Content teacher on their team for extra help, to make-up missed work or finish assignments. Teachers request and assign students to a specific subject area. Your student may call this Academic RAP or Academic Advisory.

Is there any afterschool extra help?

- Homework Club meets Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays in room 24 with Mrs. Adams.
 Students may sign up outside of room 24.
- <u>Bridge Tutoring</u> will begin on October 23, 2023 and will meet in the library. Bridge Tutors are
 East High School students who work with one to two students and provide academic
 assistance. Beck students will be signed up by their Advisory Teacher.




