The following information pertains to students returning to school in the Hybrid Model beginning November 17, 2020.

Schedule Moving Forward

- The class schedule has a 9:45 Start for all Hybrid days (Monday – Friday)
 - **The week of November 16 is currently a Hybrid Week**
- We will follow an alternating Day 5 / Day 6 schedule – See the Full Rotational Schedule [HERE](#)
 - 11/16 – Day 5 (All students are Remote on Mondays)
 - 11/17 – Day 6
 - 11/18 – Day 5
 - 11/19 – Day 6
 - 11/20 – Day 5
- Wednesday, 11/25 and Wednesday, 12/23 (**All students and teachers will work remotely**) are Early Dismissal Days

Attendance

- All students should be screened using the [Self Screener](#) prior to coming to school each day
 - Students who are sick should not attend school in person
- Students who are enrolled in the Hybrid Model will be marked **PRESENT** if they remain home and log into their classes remotely

Transportation

- To reduce traffic congestion at East in the morning, students are encouraged to take the bus to school

Safety Protocols

- Masks must be worn at all times on the buses and in the school building
- Students will use disinfectant wipes to sanitize their desks at the end of each class
- Bathrooms can be accessed during class, but will be unavailable between classes and before/after school
 - Bathroom occupancy will be limited to the number of stalls in each restroom
- Additional time has been added between classes; students are encouraged to be aware of their surroundings and to socially distance while in the hallways as they transition between classes
 - Students should remain on the right side of the hallway and utilize the designated up/down stairwell
- At least 50% of student desks have been removed from each classroom to provide for social distancing
- All Physical Education classes will be conducted outdoors; please dress appropriately
- Student dismissal will be staggered to promote social distancing

Snacks and Drink

- Lunch is **not included** in the Hybrid Schedule
 - No food or drink will be available for purchase in school
 - **Students may bring their own reusable water bottles with a straw and/or dry, nut-free snacks**
 - Students will be permitted to drink from their reusable water bottle with a straw, under their masks while in class.
 - Students will be permitted to consume their snack by stepping into the hallway, during class, at the direction of their teacher
- Students are highly encouraged to eat breakfast before coming to school
- Students/Athletes who are staying after school, should bring snacks from home to eat between 2:15pm and 2:45pm at a provided location

Technology

- Hybrid Learning model students are encouraged to bring their fully-charged device to school
 - Chromebooks will be available for use in classrooms, if needed, on a limited basis
- If a student has borrowed a district device, they are required to bring it, fully charged, with them to and from school each day
