      - Including a body temperature at/above 100.4 degrees
  - Hand Sanitizer and wipes will be available in all classrooms, large spaces and at facility entrances
  - Tri-fold plastic dividers will be available for students/families who request them
  - Traffic Flow in schools

## The Road Back – Where **WE** Are

- Students will eat lunch in school
  - Each level has designated lunch periods
    - Assigned meal times will be staggered at the elementary and middle school levels to maximize COVID mitigation
  - Lunch location options:
    - in cafeteria / APR
    - outdoors - elementary canopies
    - in classrooms
    - designated building locations - e.g. the Annex at HS East

## The Road Back – Where **WE** Are

Meals will continue to be provided free to all students

- Meals will be distributed at designated breakfast and lunch times in school
- The District will continue to work with Aramark to determine meal selection (bagged, hot, fresh fruits and vegetables)
- Building-specific information about lunches will be sent out to families in August 2021

- Cafeteria and Recess Educational Assistant Positions
  - The positions will be posted soon!
  - Looking for interested candidates!!
- Based on NJDOE / CCDOH guidelines - Children will be allowed to use the playground equipment at the Early Childhood Center and the Elementary Schools

# TRANSPORTATION

## The Road Back – Where WE Are

- Transportation
  - Regular bus routes will continue to be provided
  - Bus driver will wear a mask
  - Students must wear a mask at the bus stop and at all times on the bus
  - All students will be assigned seats and must remain in the assigned seats for the duration of the trip
    - Anyone living in the same home who attend the same school will be seated together on the bus
  - High touch areas will be sanitized in between routes
  - Buses will be cleaned each night

## The Road Back – Where **WE** Are

- Field Trips will be evaluated on an individual basis
  - And by level (elementary, middle, high school)
  - Final Determination will be made based on public health status and any mitigation requirements
  - No determination has been made regarding Mt. Misery for the incoming 6th grade, current 6th grade, and rising 8th graders, from Carusi, who did not attend
    - Protocols Mt. Misery must follow

## The Road Back – Where WE Are

- Special Education and ELL Students
  - Students who are eligible for special education and related services will fully participate
- This includes students in special classes:
  - Behavioral and Emotional Support
  - Learning and Language Disabled
  - Autistic Support
  - Multiply Disabled
  - Alternative High School
- ELL – all students in grades K-12 will attend in person

## The Road Back – Where WE Are

### Compensatory Education for Students with Disabilities

- Compensatory education for services missed during the pandemic
- Goal of compensatory education is to remedy knowledge and skill deficits, and ensure the student has the opportunity to achieve goals and objectives
- Need for compensatory education will be assessed on an individual basis by the IEP team
- Compensatory education is not determined at a 1:1 ratio when calculating the amount of services to be provided

## The Road Back – Where WE Are

### Compensatory Education for Students with Disabilities

- The IEP team determines the need, type, amount, frequency, duration, and location of compensatory education necessary to address lack of progress toward IEP goals and objectives resulting from missed services
- The IEP team will review the student's status, skill and progress
- The IEP team will propose compensatory educational services if required
- Child Study Team Case Managers can address individual questions

## The Road Back – Where WE Are

- School Aged Child Care (SACC)
  - SACC will be operational, but spots may be limited
  - Registration closed June 1st
    - Confirmation emails of acceptance and payment information will be emailed by June 30th
    - Families are being taken off the waitlist at this time.
  - Spots are filled on a first come, first served basis
  - Holiday SACC will be held on most days the schools are closed from 7:00am-6:00pm.
