

SACC REMINDERS



What are the times of SACC?

SACC runs in the morning from 7:00am until the start of school and in the afternoon beginning at 1:00pm until 6:00pm. Registered SACC students may only attend the program on the days they are physically in the building.

Will my child be able to eat breakfast during AM SACC?

No, all students need to eat snack prior to coming to AM SACC. No food will be allowed during AM SACC hours.

Will my child be able to eat lunch at SACC?

Yes, your child will be able to eat lunch during SACC. All students are to bring a nut-free bag lunch to SACC on their scheduled day. This includes plasticware, napkins, and easy to open containers. During lunch, students will be seated in accordance with social distancing. Staff will wear masks and shield while students are eating.

Will my child be able to eat snack during PM SACC?

Yes, your child will be able to eat during PM SACC. All students are to bring a dry nut-free dry snack to SACC on their scheduled day. Juice or milk will be served..

Will students and staff be required to wear a face covering during SACC?

Yes, all students, as well as staff will be required to wear a face covering while at SACC. Student face coverings will only be removed while the students are eating lunch or while outside.

Will my child be going outside to play?

Yes, students will be going outside during SACC hours. Playground equipment will not be used. Students will remain with their assigned group at all times, while social distancing.

What will my child do during SACC?

Students will have their own materials to include pencils, crayons, a glue stick, etc. Activities will include individualized crafts, non-contact games, individual reading and contact-free activities with peers.

Does my child need anything for SACC?

We are recommending each student bring a beach towel and a hat to keep in their backpack. This will allow for the staff to bring the students outside to sit and do an activity or sit on the floor inside to play a game, etc.

What do I need when dropping off or picking up my child?

When picking up or dropping off your child, you must wear a mask. The COVID-19 Health Screening Questions and temperature must be done at home prior coming to AM SACC. You will be greeted at the door and you must have your child's seven digit student identification number as well as photo identification. At PM Pick-up, Staff will bring your child to you. We ask that you remain outside and give your child a few minutes transition time.

What if my child will not be attending SACC?

If your child will not be attending SACC on their scheduled day, call the SACC Hotline at 856-429-6564 by 11:30am. There is no need to call if your child will not attend AM SACC. Our office should also be contacted if your child goes home sick.
